

Policy for Commissions

This policy aims to create a framework for commission in EYP Sweden. The framework aims to create transparency, prevent abuse of the organisation's funds, and clarify decisions made at the annual meeting regarding commissions.

Commissions

- The President receives a commission of 2000 sek per month

Rules

- Any elected official on the National level: auditors, members of the Nominating Committee, or National Safe Person, may not receive a commission unless the Annual Meeting has decided otherwise.
- The National Board must approve commissions before they are paid via a decision
 - The decision must be noted in the board meeting minutes or the next board meeting minutes if the decision is taken via email.
 - So-called super-recruiters are exempted from this clause. They are defined as “receiving monetary compensation, at a max of 999 sek, for recruiting members to EYP Sweden”
 - All members of the National Board who have a conflict of interest in a decision about the payment of commissions are expected to abstain from the decision.
- All commissions must be regulated via a signed contract before the commission is paid.
 - The contract has to be signed before any service is being rendered. Retroactive payment of a commission for a service already conducted **is not allowed**.
- This policy has to be available to all members of EYP Sweden

Decisions

- Any member, or the National Board may propose amendments to this policy at an annual meeting.
